My name is Joshua Saliba and I am the Founder of Restoration ID, a 501c3 nonprofit organization. We work with First Responders, Business Owners, Community Centers and individuals to create environments where communities can thrive in a real, tangible way.

RID started as a couple of close friends wondering what life would look like if they stopped bowing to the cultural pressures to live relatively safe lives and started living life open and whole-hearted, in how they related to both their families and others. It's from this open and vulnerable place, that RID was born and has continued to develop into a variety of ways for men and women to be restored to their true selves right in the middle of where they live, learn, work and play.

What does that look like? We believe that it looks like a group of people who share ***authentic community full of real conversations, that create a culture that matters.*** That means it shows up in a variety of ways, as diverse as the people involved.

For *First Responders*, it means RID becoming real people who do life with you instead of a faceless nonprofit that provides charity when needed. It means building relationships that start off as formal and end up as close friendships. For *Business Owners*, we offer monthly partnerships with Personal Development Days for employees. As an employer, this not only communicates that employees are valued, but it also helps them to become healthier people, translating to a healthier culture in the office, creating a more efficient work environment. For *Community Centers*, it looks like events that feed and fosters a place for people to get to know each other and have fun together. It means celebrating holidays together and finding all the places we are more alike instead of arguing over small differences. It means hosting Apprentice Experiences where the next generation is both equipped and encouraged to do life outside of math, science and reading. It means restoring a sense of community back into the culture that has created division and isolation.
